Depart from and return to Tullie House Museum (opposite Carlisle Castle)

Our Tour Guide will introduce you to the history of Carlisle Lugavalium, the Stanegate and the Wall Fort Uxellodunum as you leave the city. We will then show you many of the best views along the route of Hadrian's Wall World Heritage Site passing Lanercost Priory and Banks Turret. There will be a short stop to view the Wall remains at Birdoswald Fort. The guided tour then follows the Wall route into Northumberland National Park showing you remains of the Vallum at Cawfields and finally an option to visit the Fort and Museum at Vindolanda or to climb up to explore Housesteads Fort with a possible walk to enjoy some really fantastic views from the Wall along the Whin Sill.

Our Saturday Tour Guide will also welcome you to Carlisle with the history of the Stanegate and the Roman Wall. You will be guided through Brampton to the Irthing Valley where we will have half an hour to visit Hadrian's Wall Information Centre at Lanercost Tearoom and Gift Shop. The 12thC Lanercost Priory is just a short walk away. The tour will continue to Banks Turret to get super views south across the Valley to the Pennines as we follow the Wall earthworks to Birdoswald Fort. There is an opportunity to walk alongside the quarter mile remains of the Wall. We will pass even more views of Wall remains on the way back
